

Adverbs of Frequency (1)

What's an adverb of frequency?

It helps you to know the frequency of an activity.

jamais	presque jamais	parfois/ de temps en temps	souvent	en général	toujours
never	hardly ever	sometimes	often	usually	always

How often do you...? How often does he/she/it...? A quelle fréquence...?

How often do you do the housework? I **sometimes** do the housework.

How often does your friend go to the cinema? He **never** goes to the cinema.

Adverbs of Frequency (2)

Where do we place the adverbs of frequency in a sentence?

AFTER the verb "to be"

Jack's often hungry at night.
They're hardly ever late.
I'm always thirsty after the gym.
She's not often nice.



Jack often is hungry at night.
She often isn't nice.
I always am thirsty after the gym.



BEFORE the other verbs

I never do my homework on Monday. She always has a shower in the morning. They sometimes go shopping together.



I do never my homework on Monday. She has always a shower in the morning.



Adverbs of Frequency (3)



He doesn't never have breakfast.








He doesn't **often** drink coffee. She doesn't **always** phone me.
