

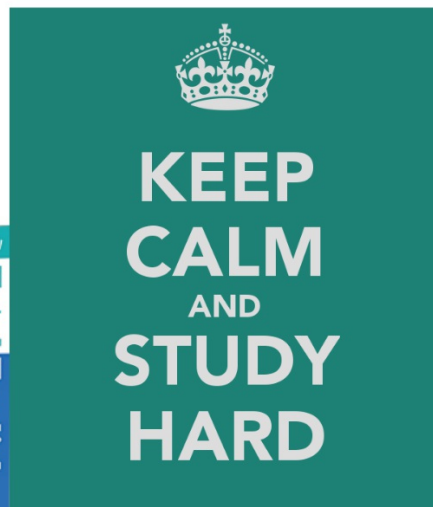

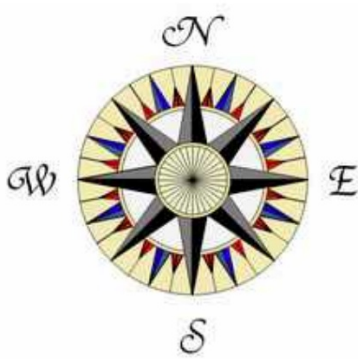

## How to Organise Your Vocabulary?

- Divide the words into relevant categories (noun, verb, adjective, etc.).
- Use colours to distinguish a category from another one.
- Use headings to facilitate your learning.
- Write the phonetic symbols (pronunciation difficulty).
- Contextualise all the words with a short, relevant sentence.

### Drinks

a can of (beer, soda, etc.)

I can only buy one can of beer.

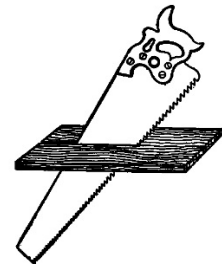

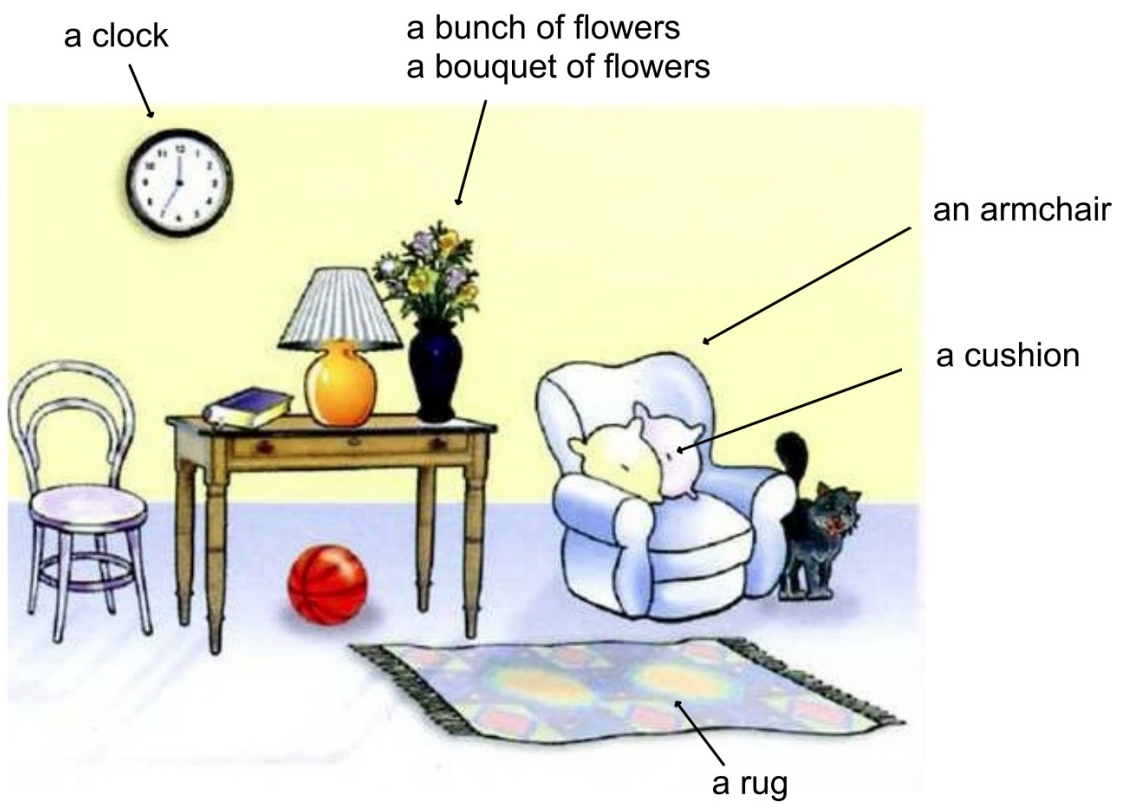

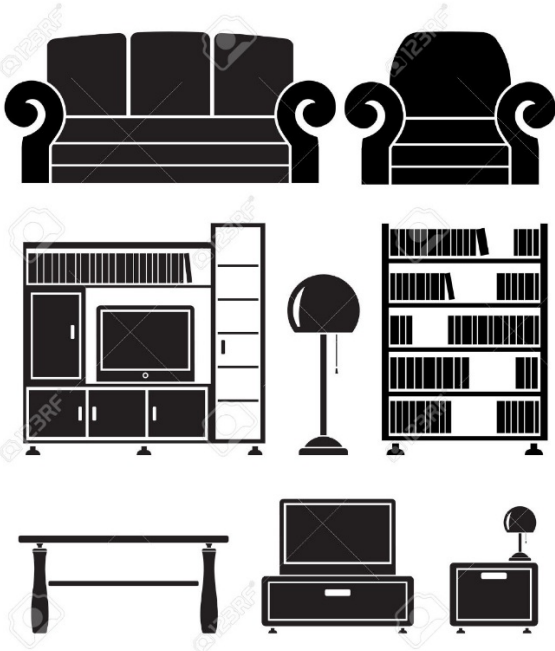

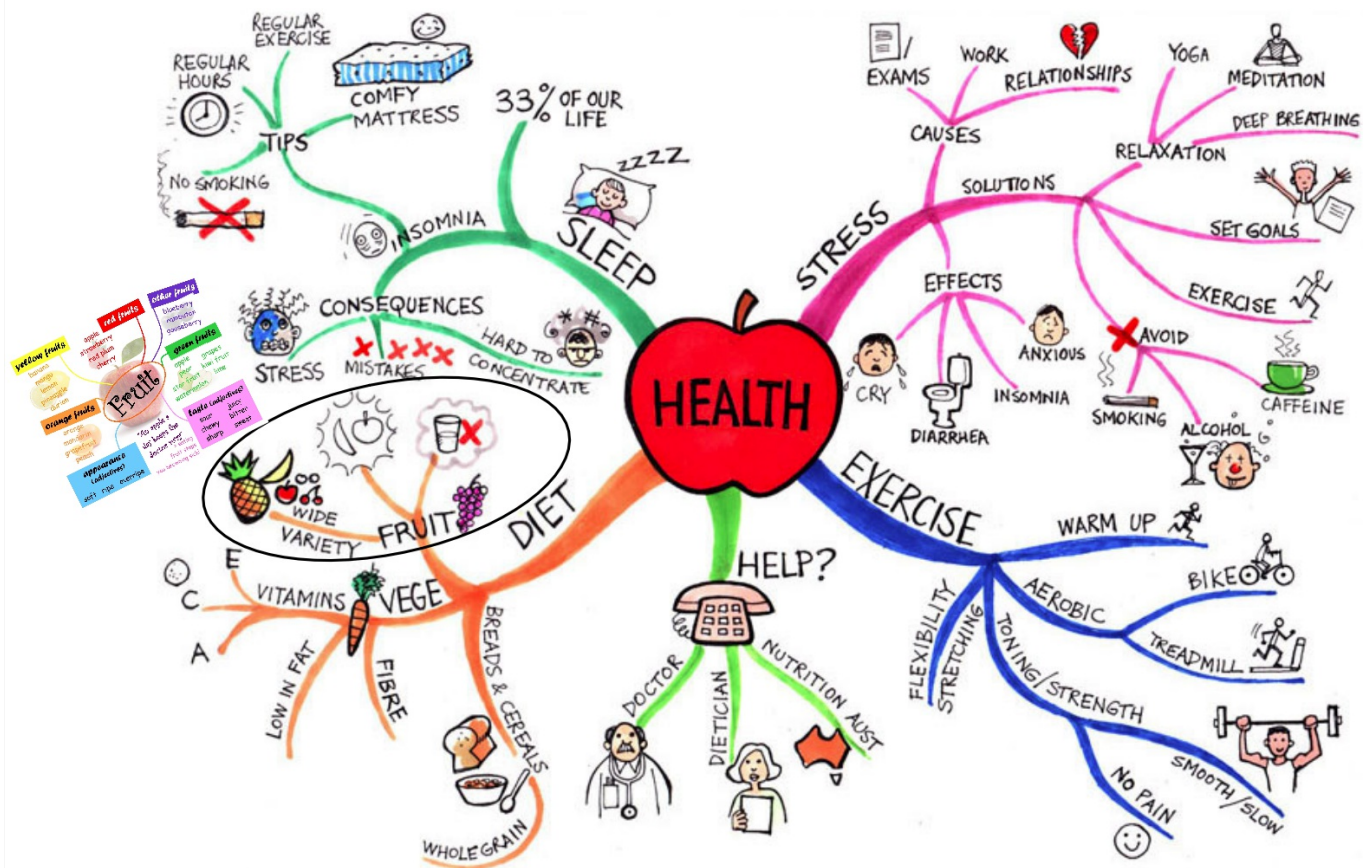
